Important: MARK ALL EQUIPMENT AND CLOTHING WITH YOUR NAME AND TROOP NUMBER! BRING ALL ITEMS STORED IN A FOOT LOCKER OR TRUNK WITH A LOCK (the trunk should be able to slide under a bed).

RECOMMENDED ITEMS: You will probably not need all of these items. It is merely a suggested list. Check the weather before all outings, or call your Patrol Leader. Be Prepared! Multiply the clothing by the number of days camping.
