- ____ Extra underwear (one pair for each day)
- ____ Sweater, fleece, or very light jacket
- ____ Hiking socks (1 pair)
- ____ Extra socks (1 pair for each day)
- ____ Handkerchief or bandanna
- ____ T-shirts (Boy Scout type, one for each day)
- ____ Boy Scout Handbook
- ____ Pen, pencil and paper/memo pad
- ____ Advancement card (Blue card)
- ____ Tote'n-chip card (if earned)
- ____ Bible or Prayer Book
- ____ cup, bowl and spoon
- ____ Pocket knife (Tote'n-chip Required)
- ____ 1qt. canteen or water bottle
- ____ Toothbrush and paste
- ____ Sunscreen
- ____ Hand-soap and container
- ____ Towel

- ____ Small daypack or belly pack (bookbag)
